CALL TO ORDER

President Jeffrey Mabee called the September 27, 2010 meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.

VISITORS

Yvonne Boyd, Carla Steele, and Gregg Stubbs presented an overview of Marysville Schools Local Report Card (LRC) as well as information regarding several state initiatives impacting current and future district work. These included:

- a) Ohio's new Resident Educator/Mentoring Program. This program mandates a new licensure system for teachers in the state - including a Resident Educator license. This four-year experience provides Ohio educators, just entering the profession, with quality mentoring and guidance essential for a long and successful career. Satisfactory completion of the residency program will be required for teachers to qualify for a five-year professional educator license.
- b) Ohio's Standards, Model Curriculum, and Assessments. In June 2010, the State Board of Education adopted the Common Core State Standards in English/Language Arts and Math as well as revisions to Ohio's Academic Content Standards in Science and Social Studies. The standards will be effective when newly aligned assessments are implemented in several years. ODE is currently facilitating the development of a Model Curriculum – a web-based tool for educators – as the next phase of refining Ohio's Comprehensive Educational System.
