



SACC Before and After School Program FAQ's 2016-2017

WHAT IS THE BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM? The Before and After School Program is operated by the Marysville Schools SACC Department. This program operates in the morning before school is in session and again after school dismisses for the day. Students are supervised in their school building by SACC staff members who are youth development experts, trained to work with school age children. Students are offered a healthy snack, 30 minutes of physical activity, a homework time (PM only) and a wide variety of youth development activities, including STEM projects, arts and crafts, games and sports, team building, and center play.

WHAT ARE THE HOURS AND DATES OF OPERATION? The Before School Program begins at 6:30 a.m. and concludes when student are dismissed for school. The After School Program begins at school dismissal and operates until 6:00 p.m. The Before and After School Program will operate on all regularly scheduled Marysville Exempted Village Schools school days. WHERE WILL THE BEFORE AND AFTER PROGRAM BE HELD? This program will be held at each of the Marysville Elementary Schools and at Creekview Intermediate. Transportation is NOT available.

WHAT IS THE COST? The fee for full time students (3-5 days per week) attending Before or After School is \$53.00/student/week. Full time students attending both Before and After School pay \$68.00/student/week. (2nd and 3rd student discounts apply). Part time students (1-2 days per week) pay \$28.00/student/week for Before of After School and \$37.00/student/week for Before and After School. We also offer a Drop In rate of \$16.00/student/day for Before or After School and a \$21/student/day for Before and After School. Drop In policies can be found in the SACC Parent Handbook.

WHAT HAPPENS IF SCHOOL IS DELAYED? If school is delayed and your student is at the Before School Program, our staff will stay on and continue to offer our program. Your account will be charged \$6.00 /event/student for this service. If your student is not in attendance, you will not be charged. If school is delayed then closed, you will be called to pick up your student from the program unless you are registered for the Emergency Weather Days Program.

HOW DO I SIGN UP? You may enroll for Summer Camp and the upcoming school year, at our enrollment night, Tuesday, April 4th. Enrollment will also be accepted throughout the year at the SACC office at Northwood Elementary. Please call first and set an appointment to fill out the forms. Students are required to be registered through the SACC office before attending any SACC program

WHAT SHOULD MY STUDENT BRING? A healthy morning and afternoon snack is provided, although students may bring their own snacks, if they wish. All SACC programs have a focus on health and wellness which includes a "no pop / no candy" policy. Students should dress for the weather and for physical activity in tennis shoes - NO open toed footwear is allowed! Do NOT bring electronics, toys, or any other items from home.
