

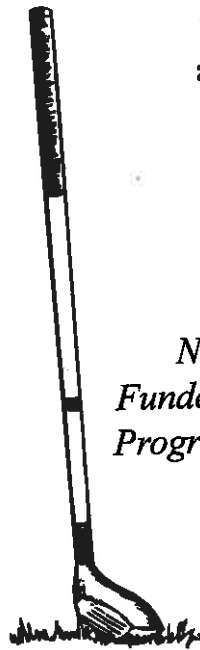

HOJGA celebrates its *33rd* year serving your children, your neighbors' and your friends' children. HOJGA salutes the entire 7-County area for its continued support through the years.

CAMP - Registration fee - \$5.00 (membership)
Cost - \$17.00 - facility use, range balls, lunch, misc.

*If Camp member wishes to play in tournaments, he/she must pay \$20.00 of remaining Registration fee before being eligible to play in tournaments (*See below).

TOURNAMENT - Registration fee *\$25.00 (\$5.00 Membership, \$20.00 for 10 Raffle tickets). All members help Association through Raffle Sales incentive-may win \$100.00 if top ticket sales winner.

Cost - 16-18 & 13-15 Divisions (18 holes) \$15.00 per tournament; 12 & Under Division (9 holes) \$10.00 per tournament. Includes golf course use, snack on turn, lunch following play, trophies, ribbons.

Guidelines - Juniors age 13-18 should **regularly score lower than 120 for 18 holes; Juniors 12 & Under, 63 or lower for 9 holes prior to signing up to play in tournaments.*
