## **SACC Emergency Weather Days Program FAQ's 2016-2017**

**WHAT IS EMERGENCY WEATHER DAYS?** The Emergency Weather Days (or E.W.D.) program is a youth development program for school aged children that operates on days when Marysville Exempted Village Schools are cancelled due to inclement weather (snow, ice, fog, temperature, etc.) Enrollment is open to all students in or outside of the Marysville Exempted Village School district. Students are supervised by qualified SACC staff members who are youth development experts, trained to work with school age students. Students are invited to participate in age-appropriate activities, including STEM, arts and crafts, sports and games.

**HOW WILL I KNOW IF THE PROGRAM IS IN OPERATION?** This program will operate any day that Marysville Schools is unexpectedly closed due to snow, ice, fog, or temperature, including during a **level 1** or a **level 2** snow emergency. We will be **CLOSED** under a **level 3** snow emergency and **may close for a level 2**. If the snow emergency level changes or the SACC program is advised to close parents will be contacted and the program will continue to operate until the last student is picked up. If you are in doubt or have questions, call the SACC office.

**WHAT ARE THE HOURS OF OPERATION?** Our program begins at 6:30 a.m. and operates until 6:00 p.m.

**WHAT ARE THE TWO DIFFERENT TYPES OF EWD?** There are two types: a **Delay to Close EWD** and an **Advanced Notice EWD**. If school is delayed then closed or closed after 6:30 a.m., all 6 SACC program sites will be open and you can take your student to his or her regular school. If school is cancelled the night before or before 6:30 a.m., then only Northwood and Navin will be open. Students who attend Edgewood, Raymond or Navin go to Navin; Students who attend Northwood or Mill Valley will go to Northwood; Students attending Creekview will go to their closest location.

**HOW CAN I FIND OUT IF IT IS A DELAY TO CLOSE OR AN ADVANCE NOTICE CANCELLATION?** You can follow Marysville Schools on TV/Radio, Facebook or Twitter. You can also follow the SACC program on Facebook. You may call the SACC office or Northwood or Navin site phones after 6:30 a.m.

**WHAT IF I WANT MY STUDENT TO COME, BUT HAVE NOT SIGNED UP IN ADVANCE??** Pre-enrollment is required! This program absolutely does not accept drop-ins, so unfortunately you will have to make other arrangements for the day.

**HOW DO I SIGN UP?** You may enroll at enrollment night, April 4th for the upcoming school year or throughout the year at the SACC office at Northwood Elementary. Please call first and set an appointment to fill out the forms. Students are required to be registered before attending any SACC program.

**WHAT SHOULD MY STUDENT BRING?** Please bring a packed lunch and drink. All SACC programs have a focus on health and wellness which includes a "no pop / no candy" policy. Students should dress for the weather and for physical activity in tennis shoes - NO open toed footwear is allowed! Do NOT bring electronics, toys, or any other items from home.
