### **RESOLUTION # 11-11**

WHEREAS, Carletta Moore began her employment with the Board of Education in April 2011 with the School Age Child Care program and was approved for a one-year limited contract for the 2011-2012 school year;

WHEREAS, Ms. Moore has not reported to duty for the 2011-2012 school year; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Moore has not requested, and is not on any approved leave of absence and has not informed the District of any fact that would qualify her for a paid or unpaid leave of absence; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Moore has failed to complete training in First Aid, CPR, Child Abuse and Neglect, and Communicable Diseases as required by the Ohio Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has provided Ms. Moore with written notice via regular and certified mail regarding his intent to recommend that the Board find she has voluntarily resigned her employment based on the abandonment of her job (i.e., based on her failure to report to duty and failure to complete required training); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Moore has not responded to the Superintendent's correspondence; and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent recommends that that the Board of Education recognize Ms. Moore's failure to report to work and failure to complete required training to constitute her voluntary resignation of her employment contract by virtue of the abandonment of her position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Board of Education recognizes Ms. Moore has voluntarily resigned her employment contract by virtue of the abandonment of her position as a School Age Child Care program staff member.
2. The Board of Education hereby severs its employment relationship with Ms. Moore.
3. The Treasurer is authorized and directed to notify Ms. Moore of the Board's action severing its employment relationship with her by virtue of the abandonment of her position with the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education directs the Treasurer to notify Ms. Moore that the Board of Education has acted to acknowledge her abandonment / voluntary resignation of employment, and that she has been removed from the Board's employment records.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is hereby found and determined that all formal action of the Board of Education concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal meetings open to the public, when required by law, were in full compliance with the law.
