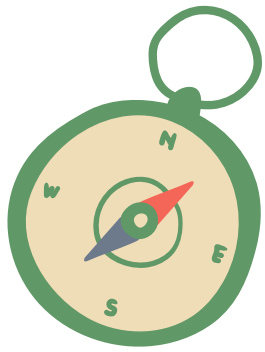

Although we cannot protect them from the pain of loss, we can make sure they build healthy coping skills.

This camp connects kids that have experienced similar loss in a safe and fun environment.

During this three day day-camp, we take part in activities like horseback riding, challenge courses, camp fires, small groups, and creative projects.

CHILDREN ARE NEVER FORCED TO SHARE

We provide a safe space for healing at camp. Campers will be surrounded by trained counselors and caring adults. We will NOT force anyone to share that is uncomfortable. Our goal is to teach healthy coping skills and create a safe environment for sharing that will help each camper heal in a way that is right for them.
