#### 2024-25 Kindergarten and Alternative Kindergarten Registration

Parents/guardians may begin the Kindergarten Registration or Alternative Kindergarten Registration process by visiting our website and submitting an online Enrollment Express entry. To be eligible for Kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year, your child must be five years of age by September 30, 2024. Any student whose birthday falls between May 1 and September 30, 2019 qualifies for the voluntary option of Alternative Kindergarten. While we report on Critical Standards, it's important to note that each subject area has other State Learning Standards that are also taught and assessed. You will not find these additional standards inside of PowerSchool.
