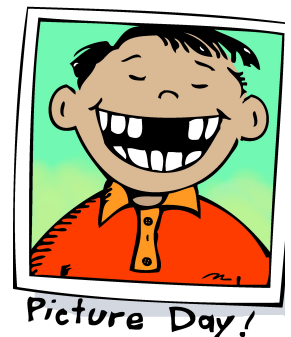

Creekview Intermediate Military Families

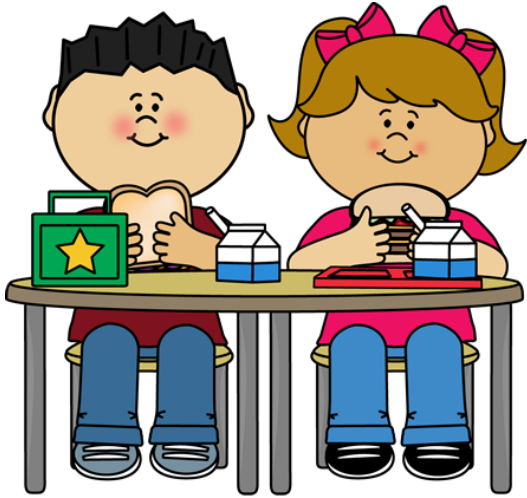

BLESSINGS IN A BACKPACK 2023-24

Your child may be eligible to be a recipient of the Blessings in a Backpack program and once the program is implemented, will receive a bag of non-perishable food every Friday during the school year. If your child is currently enrolled in, or if they will be enrolled in the free or reduced lunch program for the 2023-2024 school year, your child is eligible for Blessings in a Backpack. Backpacks will be dispensed in a discreet and caring manner. This program runs the full school year. There is no cost associated with this program. If you wish for your child to participate in the program you need to fill out an information sheet (link below).
