



Upcoming Events and Reminders



There will be no school **Monday, September 7** in observance of Labor Day. (No in-person or remote learning for students). Students will return to learning on Tuesday, September 8.

Friday, September 11 - would normally be a B & C Track day for students, however, on this date, ONLY Track C students will attend (**no in-person learning for B Track students. A & B Track students will be learning remotely on Friday, Sept. 11**). Virtual Academy students will be remote learning Tuesday, Sept. 8 - Friday, Sept. 11.

We understand that during these unique times there are many hurdles to overcome, and questions you may have, regarding learning in a hybrid/remote model. If you have not submitted your required “Back to School” information via your PowerSchool Parent Portal, please log in to your parent account and complete them now. It is important that we have updated information for each of our students in the event of an emergency.

If you are unable to access your PowerSchool Parent Portal, you can utilize the “Forgot Username or Password” option. If needed, you can contact the UC Parent Help Desk at ucparenthelp@mevsd.us, for help accessing your account. If you have the PowerSchool App on your phone/tablet, you will need to utilize a computer or web browser on your phone/tablet as the App will not allow you to gain access to the required forms.

★ Emergency Dismissal Information - REQUIRED Form

If your student is attending “in building” school using the Instructional Model 2/ Hybrid Model AA/C/BB, please make sure you return the Emergency Dismissal Information Form. This form is “**required**” for all students attending classes at Creekview Intermediate.

Reminders

★ Notes from home

Anytime there is a need to send a note to school with your child for a change in transportation, absence, etc., please include the first and last name of your child along with the name of his/her homeroom teacher.

★ Normal School Day Hours

Arrival: Creekview Interior doors will open at 8:15 a.m. this school year. Students may enter the school through entrances A (main entrance), B, C, G or I. If students are dropped off prior to 8:15 a.m., they will not have access to the building. The tardy bell rings at 8:40 a.m. Students not in their homeroom at 8:40 a.m., will be marked tardy.

Dismissal: All Creekview students will be dismissed at 3:25 p.m.

★ Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up Area

The student drop-off/pick-up area is in the main parking lot in front of the school. Parent vehicles **MUST** remain in line and students are to be dropped off and picked up **along the main front sidewalk**. In order to keep the traffic flowing, please have your student exit/enter the vehicle quickly and depart in a timely manner.. **Students will not be permitted to be dropped off or picked up in the parking area and walk through traffic.**



Parking and Traffic Flow Reminders: As you may know, traffic congestion during the start of school and dismissal causes gridlock on Creekview Drive. We ask again, that parents and students obey traffic laws, demonstrate common courtesies, comply with our crossing guards and campus supervisors, and think safety first!

★ Student Absences

If your Instructional Model 2 - Hybrid Model student is going to be physically absent from school, on a day of his/her in school learning, please contact the attendance call line at (937) 578-6615 or email creekviewattendance@mevsd.us before 9:00 a.m.

★ Late Arrivals & Early Dismissals

Due to our safety measures to help prevent the spread of COVID, we have changed a few things regarding late sign ins and early dismissals. We ask that parents not come into the building when dropping off late students. If your student is going to be late to school, please drop them off at the main school entrance (A). They will be buzzed into the building and bring their note into the office where we will get them signed in and off to class. If you need to pick your child up early, we ask that you ring the bell at the school main entrance (A) where you will be let into the main entryway. As you enter, to the left of the door, you will see a computer set up and ready for you to sign your student out of school. You will need to show an office staff member your ID through the glass. We will get your student to you as quickly as possible.

★ Bus - Going Home with a Friend

1. **Permission is dependent on emergency situation only**
2. A bus student cannot take a friend home on the bus unless PRIOR permission is given by the District Transportation Department.
3. BOTH students involved must bring a note from a parent/guardian.
4. The Transportation Department will notify the bus driver.
5. If approved, a signed permission slip from the school office will be given to your student before dismissal.

★ Change in Address:

If your permanent residency address has changed, please notify the school office immediately. You will be required to provide a new proof of residency. Contact the Creekview office at (937) 578-6600 should your address change.

 - **Monday, Nov. 23** - would normally be an A & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for A Track Students).
 - **Tuesday, Nov. 24** - would normally be an A & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for A Track Students)
- **Week of January 18-22:**
 - **Monday, Jan. 18** - No in-person or remote learning for students.
 - **Friday, Jan. 22** - would normally be a B & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for B Track students).
- **Week of February 15-19:**
 - **Monday, Feb. 15** - No in-person or remote learning for students.
 - **Friday, Feb. 19** - would normally be a B & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for B Track students).
- **Week of April 26-30:**
 - **Tuesday, April 27** - would normally be an A & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for Track A students).
 - **Wednesday, April 28** - would normally be a C Track day only but on this date, B & C Track students will attend.
 - **Thursday, April 29** - would normally be a B & C Track day but on this date, only C Track students will attend (no in-person learning for B Track students).
- **Virtual Academy Students** are not impacted as school is occurring as usual for VA students during these calendar dates.

Superintendent Update: September 2, 2020



Dear Monarch Families:

I mentioned in a communication last week that we were working on a dashboard to communicate COVID reporting. I am happy to announce that it is now live through our district website. We will update the website daily with any information or changes. You can access the dashboard by going to our website at <https://www.marysville.k12.oh.us/> and clicking on the red COVID REPORTING tab.

I want to reiterate that this dashboard does not replace the communication that may take place on an individual level due to contact tracing. Potential exposure notification will continue to take place directly with individuals through the Health Department and in coordination with our district as required. The District and Health Department will notify anyone who had close contact with any person who tests positive for the virus in one of our buildings. The District also will make general disclosures to all parents when there is a positive case in a building. In accordance with practices of the Health Department, the identity and other identifying information about the staff member or other person will not be released unless it is necessary to do so, and then only to close contacts or as part of contact tracing through the Health Department as is determined appropriate for that situation.
