WHAT IS THE PNP?

Our goal at the Union County Personal Needs Pantry (PNP) is to assist economically disadvantaged members of the community by providing them with limited products for which they are not generally eligible through other assistance programs. These goods include hygiene and cleaning products. Union County residents may visit the PNP once per month as long as a current referral is on file** (must be renewed annually for those 70 or under). Referrals are made through social service agencies, or professional agencies/individuals qualified to verify the family's state of need. Product drives are held by school, church and private groups. The PNP is operated 100% through volunteers, and all donations are used to purchase products which are distributed to our clients, or to cover overhead (rent, insurance & administrative expenses).

PLEASE NOTE:

Residents of Union County may use the Personal Needs Pantry one time per month when there is a current referral form on file. A referral is current if it has been completed within the past 12 months and there have been no changes in household membership. Seniors do not need an annual referral once they reach the age of 70, as long as there is a referral on file.

Families living in the same household will be considered one client.

Proof of residency is also required when submitting this form. A recent utility bill or driver's license can be used to show residency. Verification of household members may be required.
